Why is it important to protect stormwater?

Stormwater is water from rain or melting snow that does not soak into the ground. It flows from rooftops, over paved areas, bare soil, and sloped lawns. As it flows, stormwater runoff collects litter, animal waste, salt, pesticides, fertilizers, oil and grease, soil and other potential pollutants, and washes them into the storm drains. Storm drains generally flow directly to the Ottawa River without treatment. That's why it's so important to keep everything but clean water from going down the drain and impacting drinking water.
